

# Policy Discussion – Code of Conduct

May 21 Draft Revised Language revised by staff in response to Council interest that the LUCA not be perceived as criminalizing homelessness.

- f. Code of Conduct for individuals granted access to the proposed Homeless Services Uses including, but not limited to:
- ~~i. Prohibition on entry into surrounding properties that do not have a retail function (such as office spaces);~~
  - ii.i. Promotion of travel paths that use the public rights-of-way;
  - ~~iii. Restrictions on loitering and trespassing;~~
  - iv.ii. No littering Shared commitment to maintaining the Homeless Services Use and preserving the site aesthetics;
  - ~~v.iii.~~ Restriction on smoking to designated areas of the site;
  - ~~vi. Compliance with City of Bellevue regulations governing public conduct (e.g. camping, lewd acts, urinating in public, etc.);~~
  - vii.iv. Compliance with terms of Good Neighbor Agreement provisions applicable to occupants of the Homeless Services Use;
  - viii.v. Description of how occupants of the Homeless Services Uses will be notified regarding the Code and Conduct; and
  - ~~ix.vi.~~ Description of consequences to be imposed for violating the Code of Conduct.

## Policy Questions Raised in Preparation for Public Hearing Draft:

- Has the City Council’s interest been met with the revised code language to ensure the LUCA is not perceived as criminalizing homelessness?
- Should a Community Service Program be included that requires Operator and occupant participation?
- Should grounds for removal from the shelter (e.g., for disruptive behavior, theft, illegal drug use, etc.) be included?
