## CONSTRUCTION ALERT

### NE Spring Blvd - 120th to 124th Ave NE

### October 2019 through the end of 2020

Construction of the next segment of NE Spring Blvd begins in October. The new multi-modal 4-lane roadway will feature sidewalks with bicycle paths, on-street parking on the north side, landscaping and utility improvements. Four traffic signals will also be installed, two of which will be pedestrian-focused for access to the future Spring District/120th Street light rail station.

**Expect periodic lane closures** at the intersection of NE Spring Blvd at 120th Ave NE. The intersection with 124th Ave NE will also be closed for up to 12 weekends in coordination with the current through traffic closure between NE 12th Street/Bel-Red Road and Northup Way for the 124th Ave NE Corridor project.
