# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## 124th Avenue NE Corridor Safety Improvements: NE 8th Street to NE 12th Street

November 2020

The Bellevue Transportation Department plans to make the following safety improvements along 124th Avenue NE, between NE 8th and NE 12th Streets. Refer to map.

- Sidewalk with curb ramp improvements on the west side of 124th Avenue NE, from NE 8th Street to NE 10th Place;
- Median with a flashing beacon and mid-block crossing south of NE 10th Place; and,
- Eight new streetlights on both sides of 124th Avenue NE.

- **Approved work hours:** 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday – Friday.
- **Noise:** Expect noise, especially with sidewalk and roadway work.
- **Pedestrian/bicycle access** will be maintained.
- **Local access to businesses** will be maintained. Flaggers will direct traffic in and out of driveways.

### What to expect:

- **Schedule:** Construction is anticipated to begin in early December. Streetlight installation will come at a later date.
- **Traffic impact:** Lane closures with traffic control flaggers.

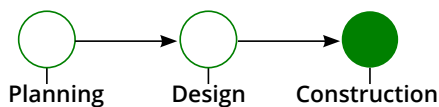
