124th Avenue NE Corridor Improvements

September 2020

Electrical lattice tower replacement

Construction to replace two Seattle City Light lattice electrical towers with monopoles is expected to begin in September and be complete in November.

- **Traffic impact:** Full 24-hour roadway closure between NE District Way and King County Metro driveway access is anticipated from mid-October to mid-November.
- **Approved work hours:** Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Detour:** Follow detours via 120th and 132nd Aves. NE
- **Equipment:** Large cranes to assemble/disassemble poles.
- **Pedestrian/bicycle access** will be maintained on the east side of 124th Ave. NE.
- **Local access** to businesses will be maintained.
