A Guide to Parking Laws

PARK SMART • A Guide to Parking Laws



NO PARKING within 5 feet from a driveway (RCW 46.61.570)



NO PARKING within 20 feet from a crosswalk (RCW 46.61.570)



NO PARKING more than 12 inches from the curb (RCW 46.61.575)




NO PARKING within 15 feet from a fire hydrant (RCW 46.61.570)



NO PARKING within 10 feet in either direction of a mail box from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on delivery days (BCC 11.23.028)



NO PARKING on the sidewalk whether fully or partially (RCW 46.61.570)



NO PARKING within 20 feet from the corner (RCW 46.61.570)



NO PARKING within 30 feet from a stop sign (RCW 46.61.570)



Vehicles must be parked with the right-hand wheels parallel to the curb or edge of roadway. (RCW 46.61.575) ($\sqrt{}$ is the correct way to park)


NO PARKING a vehicle for more than 24 **hours** on either side of a public street within the same block. Vehicles must move to a different block every 24 hours. (BCC 11.23.020)

NO PARKING in a fire lane (BCC 23.11.503)

Vehicles parked on a street with an expired registration of more than 45 days may be towed at the owner's expense. (RCW 46.55.113)

NO PARKING with a "For Sale" sign in the vehicle (WAC 308-330-436)

NO PARKING when "No Parking Anytime" or time limit restrictions are present (RCW 46.61.570)



NO PARKING over a white painted edge **line** or into the traveled portion of a roadway or bike lane (BCC 11.23.025) (√ is the correct way to park)



NO PARKING facing the opposite direction of the flow of traffic (RCW 46.61.575) (√ is the correct way to park)
