Hazardous Waste

Hazardous waste does not go in your trash container. Hazardous materials require special handling. Every business must comply with regulations, no matter how little hazardous waste it generates. The amount of waste the business produces or stores determines which regulations apply. Visit KingCountyhazwastewa.gov or call 206.296.4692 to find out:

- if your business is eligible to receive no-fee disposal options.
- what types of hazardous products are accepted at local disposal locations.
- how to join a free listing service that helps your business locate useful materials or give away surplus materials and hazardous products.

Recycling and Composting Service at No Additional Cost

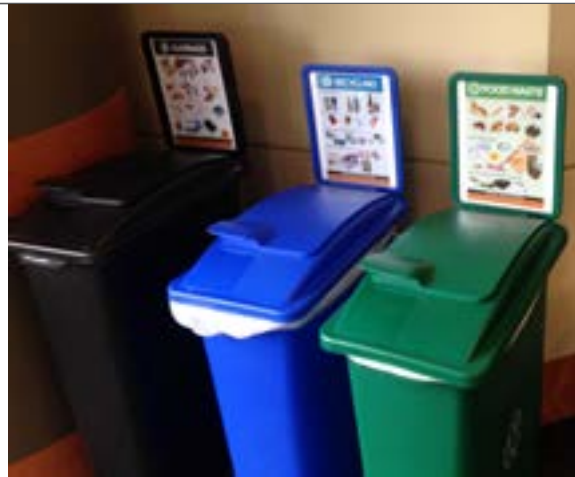

Additional Guidelines

Bad Weather Conditions



If weather conditions prevent safe collection, up to double the material will be collected on your next regular collection day at no additional charge.

Holiday Schedule

Observed holidays are Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. If your collection day falls on or after that day during the week, your pickup day will shift to the following day (example: Thursday collection will move to Friday, Friday collection will move to Saturday, etc.)
