

# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

### 124th Avenue NE Corridor Safety Improvements:

NE 12th Street to NE Spring Boulevard

October 2021

The Bellevue Transportation Department continues to make safety improvements along 124th Avenue NE. The next phase of improvements is between NE 12th Street and NE Spring Boulevard.

#### What to expect

- Schedule: Construction November 2021 through fall 2022. Construction schedules are subject to change and often do.
- Traffic impact: Intermittent lane closures and detours for partial intersection closures of 124th Avenue NE at NE 12th Street and at District Way at 124th Avenue NE (See map). Please follow flaggers' instructions and detour signs. Detailed closure information will be mailed once schedule is known.
- **Approved work hours**: 7 a.m.-6 p.m., Monday-Friday.
- Pedestrian/bicycle access will be maintained via detours.
- **Driveway acces**s to businesses will be maintained.

#### **Funding**

The total project budget is \$21.3 million and will be partially funded by the city's Capital Investment Program, state Transportation Improvement Board and a federal Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act Ioan.
