Thank you for participating in the Newport Neighborhood Enhancement Program!

In June and July 2022, 498 ballots (13% of Newport households) were returned on the 10 proposed enhancement projects to receive Neighborhood Enhancement Program (NEP) funds. Two projects will be funded out of the \$282,000 Newport NEP allocation, which will also encompass associated planning, design, labor, and materials fees.

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## Neighborhood Enhancement Program Newport NEP Funded Project Locations





**Funded projects to be implemented by Neighborhood Enhancement Program over the next three to five years.**

**NP-1: Newport Hills Property Forest Enhancement**  
**\$90,000**                      **602 points**

*Newport Hills Property, 11450 SE 60th St*

This project will involve the removal of non-native plants from natural forested areas within the Newport Hills Property. The scope of work will involve the removal of blackberry and ivy from the forest floor and the removal of ivy growing up existing native trees. Other non-native invasive weeds will also be removed as they are encountered. All impacted areas will be replanted with native trees and shrubs that are suitable for site conditions.

**NP-4: SE 60th/120th Crosswalk**  
**\$195,500**                      **409 points**

*Intersection of SE 60th and 120th Ave SE (at the NE corner of Newport Hills Park)*

This project will install a new pedestrian-activated flashing system at the existing crosswalk over SE 60th St at 123rd Ave SE. Flashing beacons will be added on each side of the street. The proposed project will include associated street lighting upgrades and a new curb ramp on the north side of street.
