

Permit Timelines and Development Update



Development Update

- Applications and permits higher than expected in 2024
- Valuation of building permits lower than expected in 2024
- Inspection volumes decreased throughout 2024
- In the pipeline high volume of multi-family projects
- 2025 forecast similar volumes and level of investment
- Continue to focus efforts on process improvements



Permit Timelines

- First review decision performance improving in most areas
- Resources combination of staffing and consultants
- Land Use permits 2025 focus on managing shot clocks
- Building permits 2025 focus on consolidated review
- Resource streamlining measures adopted with 25-26 budget



SB 5290 Implementation

- Land Use Code changes adopted and effective January 1
 - Codified permit timelines for project permits
 - Procedural changes and updates
 - Director rulemaking
- Streamlining measures adopted and effective January 1
 - 3 resourcing measures implemented with 25-26 budget
 - Exempts city from permit fee refunds



SB 5290 Implementation

- Process and procedure updates
 - Pre-apps required for critical areas and short plats
 - Submittal requirement updates on web and MBP Live January 13
 - New checklists developed to improve application guidance
 - Strengthening project management on Land Use permits
- Performance reporting due to Commerce in March 2025



Engineering and Site Design Sub Team Proposal



- New BDC Sub-Team proposed for site, land use, and civil engineering (transportation and utilities) permitting and construction
- Focus on issues outside of building envelope, in public street right-of-way, or area between the right-of-way and the building
- Desired outcomes are to identify, prioritize, and address issues and needed process improvements





- Sub-team to work collaboratively to resolve issues and improve overall design/review/inspection processes for all participants of the process
- Potential Topics and Issues:
 - Issues occurring during design review, construction or the transition from review to construction
 - Schedule issues on projects
 - Reoccurring or specific project issues

- Single family building permits consolidated review Q2
 - Submittal documents being simplified and combined
 - Consolidated revision submittals will be required
 - Project management


