Bellevue Police Department Officer-Involved Shooting

Bellevue, WA - On December 9, 2024, at approximately 10:00 a.m. Bellevue Police Officers responded to a Factoria neighborhood in the 4300 block of 120th Ave SE for a report of a harassment with a knife.

Bellevue Officers responded to the scene and contacted an individual. During the incident, the individual was shot by officer(s) of the Bellevue Police Department. Officers attempted lifesaving measures at the scene, but unfortunately the individual did not survive.

The Independent Force Investigative Team of King County (IFIT-KC) responded to the scene and is conducting an independent use of force investigation.

This is an ongoing investigation, IFIT-KC Investigators continue to interview witnesses and review digital evidence that captured the event.
