


WHAT IS NEP?

- COUNCIL DIRECTED, CITY-FUNDED, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM
- EMPOWERS RESIDENTS TO PROPOSE AND SELECT ENHANCEMENT PROJECTS FOR THEIR INDIVIDUAL AREAS
- \$5 MILLION BUDGET DISTRIBUTED AMONG 14 DEISIGNATED NEIGHBORHOOD AREAS
- AREA ALLOTMENT BASED ON THE NUMBER OF HOUSEHOLDS IN EACH NEIGHBORHOOD AREA.
- ROTATES THROUGH THE 14 NEIGHBORHOOD AREAS OVER SEVEN YEAR PERIOD (2015-2022)
- CURRENTLY 12 NEP PROJECTS IN PROGRESS IN THE CITY IN FOUR NEIGHBORHOOD AREAS

- 5. CITY IMPLEMENTS PROJECTS IN 3-5 YEARS

PROJECT CRITERIA

AFFORDABILTY

PROJECT COSTS MUST NOT EXCEED THE FUNDING ALLOCATION FOR THE NEIGHBORHOOD AREA

CONSISTENCY

PROJECTS MUST BE CONSISTENT WITH CITY PLANS AND POLICIES

FEASIBILITY

PROJECTS MUST BE PRACTICAL AND ACHIEVABLE FOR THE CITY

IMPLEMENTATION

PROJECTS MUST BE DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTED WITHIN 3-5 YEARS OF SELECTION

MAINTAINABILITY

PROJECTS MUST NOT REQUIRE MAINTENANCE THAT IS BURDOMESONE TO THE CITY

PUBLIC BENEFIT

PROJECTS MUST BE LOCATED ON PUBLIC PROPERTY, EASEMENTS, OR PROPERTY DESIGNATED FOR PUBLIC USE, AND MUST BENEFIT THE GENERAL PUBLIC
