

Dear Community Member,

We hope to create an opportunity for you to have greater understanding of the diverse stories, needs, and worldview of those who are experiencing homelessness on the Eastside. This understanding can help in creating a welcoming, safe, supportive community, for those currently housed and unhoused. Therefore, we welcome you to visit our Shelter and Daytime Service Center located at the Lincoln Center in Bellevue and gain a greater sense of awareness and understanding of your neighbors that are experiencing homelessness and the work that CFH has been doing to provide safe, welcoming spaces for them to rest with the support needed to restore their lives.

Follow these steps to plan your visit

- Select a group of no more than 5 people, per visit, if the visit is during service hours (if outside of service hours, we welcome larger groups)
- Plan for daytime visit between 11 and 1pm Sunday through Thursday and/or evening visit between 7pm and 8pm any day.
