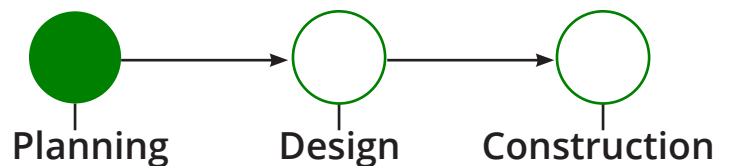
### Intersection Study Areas:

As a part of the Neighborhood Safety, Connectivity and Congestion Levy, the City will evaluate how to improve traffic flow and safety at the intersections of:

- Lakemont Boulevard SE and Forest Drive SE
- Lakemont Boulevard SE and SE Newport Way
- I-90 Eastbound on-ramp on SE Newport Way  
(see map on reverse side)

Proposed improvements may result in different changes at each intersection.

**Project Schedule:** Concept design alternatives will be presented at the Open House for feedback. A final design recommendation report and design concept will be completed in June 2019.

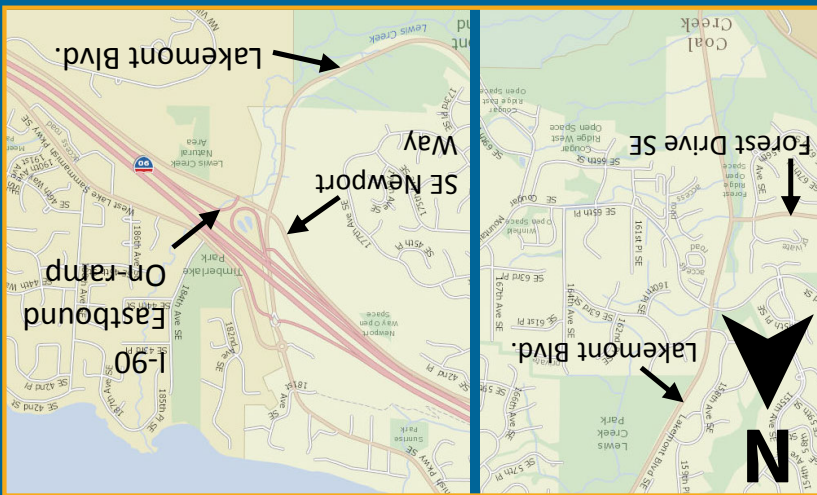
