Resolution No. 545

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Ordinance No. 6190 amending the Bellevue Land Use Code to create a new Part 20.25N – Camp and Conference Center – of the Bellevue Land Use Code (Title 20 BCC); and amending the following sections of the Land Use Code for consistency with the new Part 20.25N; LUC 20.10.020 – Establishment of land use districts, LUC 20.10.100 – District descriptions, Chapter 20.10 LUC – Land Use Districts, 20.10.440 – Land use charts, and LUC 20.25B.020.B – Transition Area Design District; providing for severability, and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of November 2014, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Ordinance No. 6190 amending the Bellevue Land Use Code to create a new Part 20.25N – Camp and Conference Center – of the Bellevue Land Use Code (Title 20 BCC); and amending the following sections of the Land Use Code for consistency with the new Part 20.25N; LUC 20.10.020 – Establishment of land use districts, LUC 20.10.100 – District descriptions, Chapter 20.10 LUC – Land Use Districts, 20.10.440 – Land use charts, and LUC 20.25B.020.B – Transition Area Design District; providing for severability, and establishing an effective date; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Ordinance falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on December 2, 2014, the Community Council voted to approve Bellevue Ordinance No. 6190;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue:


Section 1: Ordinance No. 6190 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.
