A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Ordinance No. 4693, reclassifying various properties located south on Main St. and north of SE 24th Street; from 148th Ave. SE to 156th Ave. SE in the Lake Hills Greenbelt area from Open Use (OU) and Neighborhood Business (NB) to Single Family R-1, R-1.8, R-3.5 and R-5, upon application of the City of Bellevue, and known as the Lake Hills Rezone Group.

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of September, 1994 the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Ordinance No. 4693, reclassifying property in the Lake Hills Greenbelt; and

<u>Section 1:</u> The Findings, Conclusions and Conditions adopted by the Bellevue City Council relative to Ordinance No. 4693 are hereby adopted by the East Bellevue Community Council as though fully set forth herein.

<u>Section 2:</u> Ordinance No. 4693 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.

Section 3: The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this Resolution, to file the same and to keep the same on file in her office. The Clerk is further directed to distribute certified or conformed copies of this Resolution to the Bellevue City Council, the Office of Policy Planning, and the Department of Community Development.
